TRAFFIC ADVISORY **COLLEGE HEIGHTS**

The City of Watertown's Department of Public Works crews will begin the process of paving College Heights from Coffeen Street into the dead end at Home Depot. This will take place beginning at **7:00 am on Friday, October 12th**.

College Heights will be reduced to one lane of traffic during this time.

Public Works crews will follow standard protocol to establish traffic control by installing temporary barricades, signage, and having on-site flagmen throughout the duration of the project.

Local residents should make arrangements to park on nearby side streets while this work is underway. Motorists should exercise caution when encountering work crews and work zones.
