

## **CIVIL ENGINEER II**

Candidate must qualify for and pass Civil Service examination. Minimum qualifications are: Graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered college or university with a Bachelor’s degree in civil engineering or closely related engineering field & 4 yrs of civil engineering exp.; **or** graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered college or university with an Associate’s degree in civil engineering or closely related engineering field & 9 years of engineering exp. 4 of which are in civil engineering; or possession of NYS Prof. Engineer’s License & 4 yrs civil engineering exp. (1 year of graduate study in engineering may be substituted for 1 year of the req. exp). Must obtain NYS PE license within 2 years of appointment & maintain engineering license for continued employment. Salary \$65-\$74K depending on qualifications and experience.
