TRAFFIC ADVISORY & STREET CLOSINGS PEARL STREET RESURFACING

The City of Watertown's Department of Public Works crews are in the process of resurfacing Pearl Street from the Pearl Street Bridge to the City Limits. **Saturday, June 2, 2007** Public Works crews will re-pave the section of Pearl Street from the Pearl Street Bridge towards the City Limits. Work is scheduled to begin **Saturday at 5:00 a.m. and is expected to last throughout the day. The project will resume on Monday, June 4, 2007 at 6:00 a.m.** The re-paving portion of this project should be complete by the early evening hours of Monday, June 4th.

A single lane of traffic will be maintained on Pearl Street throughout the duration of the project; however, long delays are to be expected when traveling on Pearl Street. **Water Street, Marble Street, the East Main Street Extension and intersection of East Main, Pearl, and Starbuck will be CLOSED throughout the project.**

Public Works crews will install temporary barricades, signage and have flagmen on-site throughout the duration of the project. Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes on these dates. If traveling through, motorist should exercise extreme caution when encountering work crews and work zones.
