TRAFFIC ADVISORY – STERLING & GOODALE STREETS

The City of Watertown's Department of Public Works crews will begin the process of resurfacing Sterling and Goodale Streets. This work will encompass Sterling Street from Washington Street to Franklin Street and the entire stretch of Goodale Street. The first step will be the milling/grinding operations, with weather permitting, is scheduled to begin **Friday, July 27, 2007 at 6:00 a.m.** and expected to last throughout the day.

A single lane of traffic will be maintained on Sterling Street throughout the duration of the project; however, long delays are to be expected when traveling on Sterling Street. **Goodale Street will be CLOSED throughout the project.**

Local residents should make arrangements to park on nearby side streets while this work is underway. Public Works crews will install temporary barricades, signage and have flagmen on-site throughout the duration of the project. Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes on this date. If traveling through, motorist should exercise extreme caution when encountering work crews and work zones.

Upon completion of the milling/grinding operation, crews will remain on Sterling and Goodale Streets in order to make any necessary repairs to the street and street structures prior to the resurfacing of the street.
