

Owners Must Clean Sidewalks

WATERTOWN, N.Y. - As our crews continue the clean-up operations following the recent snow storm we want to remind everyone that it is the responsibility of the home owner to ensure that the sidewalks abutting their properties are kept clean of ice and snow.

As always, we ask that, when clearing your walks and driveways, to please not put the snow into the street but to instead deposit it onto the margins.

In those instances where your margin areas are insufficient to adequately store the snow, place the snow on the property side of the walk.

We also ask your cooperation in refraining from parking your vehicles on the city streets as much as possible in order to make it easier and safer for our plows scrape the road surface and push back the banks.
